COSTUMING

ALL CAST MEMBERS: Solid color top and solid color bottoms. NO JEANS. NO BLACK. The Cast members are meant to be traveling street artists with only as many belongings as they can carry. The plays take place in different parts of the world, so if there is an accent piece that you think you may have that fits the location of the play; please bring it in to be approved. Layers are essential in this play. Members who have shawls or hats that they think go with their character, please bring them in to be approved.

We can provide most accent pieces thanks to Merrie Whitney, however there will be a small costume fee.

If you buy something, DO NOT REMOVE THE TAG until it is approved.

Specifics

*** If your character is blank that means your solid color costume is what you should wear. You will be given a prop or accent piece.

Players: Should have some red accent in their costume. It can be their pants, shirt, a scarf, and head piece.

Grandfather's Eyes (location: Czechoslovakia)

Old Man- sun glasses

Goats- white accent piece (sweater, head piece, etc.)

Yanecheck-

Maiden 1,2,3- shawl, cardigan

The Lost Beads (location: South Africa)

Older sister 1,2,3 & younger sister- shawl, wrist bracelet

Water- blue accent piece

Prince Ivan, the Witch, and the Little Sister of the Sun (location: Russia)

Old Caretaker- dark colored cloak shawl

Prince- a vest

Decrepit woman 1&2- dark cloak/shawl

Tree-Rooter- brown or forest green accent piece & green hat or beanie

Mountain tosser- grey accent piece

Sun's sister- yellow accent piece

Witch- black shawl/cloak, or cardigan

My Lord Bag of Rice (Japan)

Hidesato- kimono or robe

Dragon King- kimono or robe

Centipede- brown accent piece

The Story of the Yara (Brazil)

Alonzo – blue scarf or vest

Julia – blue shawl or wrap

Yara – some sort of cape; needs to appear “ghost-like”

Prince Half- A- Son (India)

All ladies need a scarf of some sort to wear around their head.

Faqir – sandals, not flip flops

Kings 1 and 2 – crown

Half-a-Son

Queens – jewels

Siblings – matching scarfs

The Little Owl Boy (Arapaho Indian)

If cast members in this scene have moccasins, please bring them.
