MATILDA PRODUCTION REQUIREMENTS:

1. FPAC does not charge an audition or participation fee. We do require, however, that adult cast members and the parents of young participants meet a fundraising requirement of at least \$75.00 by selling advertising or by obtaining programming donations at Encore/Ovation/Bravo/Prelude levels. The Franklin Performing Arts Company is a non-profit organization committed to promoting the arts by producing quality productions and providing performing opportunities for professionals, amateurs, and students. Your support is needed and appreciated in order to produce our ambitious seasons of shows. Printed fundraising materials and forms can be downloaded from the FPAC website.

2. Performers must be available for all rehearsals and performances. Commitment to the rehearsal schedule is required.

CAST POSTINGS:

COSTUME RENTAL POLICY:

1. Performers may be responsible for a rental fee for his/her costume(s). Most rental fees range from \$30-\$60 per performer. College students may request an exemption. Rented costumes are the property of or are rented by FPAC and are returned at the conclusion of the performances.

Some of *Matilda* costuming may be provided by the performers with guidelines provided. All costuming must be approved. Do not remove tags from newly purchased items before approval.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE
