## **PARTICIPATION FEES:**

- 1. \$195 per performer for Ballet Works.
- 2. All participation fees are now due.
- 3. Students will be responsible for a costume rental fee. Be sure to check the website for costume fitting sign-up info.

# **REQUIREMENTS**:

- 1. Commitment to the rehearsal schedule is required.
- 2. Students must be picked up from rehearsals on time.

#### TICKETS:

- 1. Pre-sale cast member tickets will be available as of 2/12 and must be purchased by 2/27. There is a ticket requirement of 4 per family. Please contact the FSPA Office when tickets go on sale.
- 2. You have 2 opportunities to watch the premiere showings (3/27 at 7:00 and 3/28 at 2:00). When you purchase tickets, you will need to specify which dates you want links for. There will also be an on-demand option.
- 3. As soon as your ticket transaction has gone through, you will receive an email with a ticket link from Showtix4u.
- 4. If you purchased tickets for Ballet Works last year, they will be transferred to this year. Please contact Kim R. at krezendes@fspaonline.com if you need to purchase more tickets to fulfill your requirement.
- 5. Once all cast members have purchased their required 4 tickets, tickets will go on sale (via <u>online</u> sales or through the FSPA Office or The Spotlight Shop).

#### **CAST INFORMATION:**

#### **REHEARSALS:**

- 1. Students or parents are responsible for knowing the rehearsal times. Check the website (www.fspaonline.com) if unsure. Any changes in the rehearsal schedule will be posted in red. Please check regularly for postings and updates!
- 2. Rehearsals will be scheduled at various times. Please check with the director if there is a conflict with an FSPA class and rehearsal.

### **ATTENDANCE:**

Please arrive on time for rehearsals. Phone calls to the office are expected if a rehearsal must be missed. Repeated or unexcused absences will result in dismissal from the cast. Absences will be excused for illness or emergency only or if excused to attend a class at FSPA. Cast members may not miss rehearsals due to sports, other productions, or other activities. Any exception must be approved in advance by the director.
