## **TOYS**

Each performer is costumed as an "old-fashioned" toy. Some of our favorites have included: xylophone, snow globe, gumball machine, Mr./Mrs. Potato Head, etch-a-sketch, play doh, crayon, slinky, stack rings, lego, jack-in-the-box, kite, rocking horse, pez dispenser, paint palette, block.

No Sponge Bob, Star Wars characters, Barney etc. NO dolls or stuffed animals. Be creative! Try classic toy websites and Pinterest for ideas.

#### **YOUTH**

Outdoor clothes – pants or skirts (with tights) with sweaters, vests or jackets. Fleece is perfect. Choose bright, warm colors. Mix the colors in your outfit. Plaids or stripes are good – no prints. No visible logos on clothing. NO JEANS! Do not wear anything made with nylon "ski jacket" material. We are not looking for Christmas colors in this scene. Wear boots you can move in. Uggs work well!

#### **YOUNG TEENS**

Outdoor clothes – pants or skirts (with tights) with sweaters, vests or jackets. Fleece is perfect. Choose bright, warm colors. Mix the colors in your outfit. Plaids or stripes are good – no prints. No visible logos on clothing. NO JEANS! Do not wear anything made with nylon "ski jacket" material. We are not looking Christmas colors in this scene. Wear boots you can move in. Uggs work well!

## **ELVES**

Elf colors are red and green only. A little bit of trim in white, black, silver, gold is okay. NO theme or stereotyped characters! Simply look like an elf!

Choose "quirky" accessories – hair accessories, glasses, badge, sash, belt, apron, etc. Elf shoes – see Elf Shoe memo

Striped socks or tights are great; red/green stripes, polka dots, patterns are good for costuming. NO visible logos or writing.

White outdoor sweater with black pants/slacks/leggings. Scarf provided.
