Production Week Memo May 4, 2015

PERFORMANCES: Saturday, May 16 4:00 & 7:00 p.m. and Sunday, May 17 1:00 & 4:00 p.m.

- 1. The box office is open! Tickets are currently available in The Spotlight Shop, online at www.fspaonline.com and will be sold at the door. Advanced purchase is recommended. Seating is reserved and seats may be selected if tickets are purchased in advance. Tickets will be sold in a "general admission" fashion at the door. **Ticket holders will be seated twenty minutes before curtain**. There is no convenience fee if tickets are purchased in person.
- 2. There is NO PHOTOGRAPHY and NO VIDEOTAPING allowed at FSPA performances. Also, no FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY at Dress Rehearsal, please. It is dangerous and very distracting to the performers! Spring Concert 2015 will be professionally taped and DVDs are available for \$47.00. Orders may be placed at the Spotlight Shop or at Spring Concert. Please specify Saturday 4:00 or 7:00, or Sunday 1:00 or 4:00 show when ordering.
- 3. EVERY performer will participate in the show Finale. All performers (including children) will remain backstage, supervised, throughout the performance. Performers are welcome to view dress rehearsal, accompanied by one parent.
- 4. PLEASE no food allowed when in costume and absolutely no food or beverages allowed in the auditorium. Backstage water only!! Juices and soda will stain costumes. Children should bring quiet games, puzzles, coloring or homework to keep busy backstage. Biding time backstage is part of "show biz".
- 5. The Spotlight Shop will offer an array of congratulatory gifts in festive wrapping for purchase in the lobby at each show.

ARRIVAL TIMES

THE ENTIRE CAST MUST BE CHECKED IN BACKSTAGE BY:

Ages 5-10 45 minutes prior to curtain

Ages 11 and up 60 minutes prior to curtain

ALL VOICE CLASSES 60 minutes prior to curtain

You must be on time for the show "call time" as some additional rehearsals may be held.

**Performing Troupes and GLEE CLUB will be waiting in the wings ready to rehearse 90 minutes prior to curtain.

COSTUME PICK UP

Those who did not pick up their costumes during class may get their costumes in the FPSA Office. All costumes must be picked up prior to dress rehearsal. **NO costumes will be brought to the auditorium for pickup.**

REHEARSALS

YOUNG PERFORMERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED AND SUPERVISED BY <u>ONLY ONE PARENT</u> <u>OR GUARDIAN</u> AT AUDITORIUM REHEARSALS!! Be sure to be on time and prepared for rehearsal. Only one parent will be allowed in the auditorium with each student.

- 1. THERE IS NO SEATING IN THE FRONT SECTIONS FOR REHEARSALS AT THE AUDITORIUM. This is necessary to coordinate the concert with the technical staff and choreographers. The lobby at the rear of the auditorium is available for conversation. The auditorium, however, MUST REMAIN QUIET throughout rehearsals.
- 2. The doors beside the stage may not be used at any time.

BACKSTAGE POLICY: Children will be supervised backstage and escorted to the stage by preassigned parent volunteers wearing badges. Other parents will not be allowed backstage during the performance.

IMPORTANT - One Way Dismissal Procedure:

One parent only will be allowed to pick up a performer backstage. All children 13 and younger <u>must</u> be met backstage by a parent. One parent holding a "backstage ticket" will be allowed backstage to the supervised room for pick up: You will exit outside near the gym or you may follow the long hallway around to the lobby. You may not exit the way you came in. Performers 14 and older will exit through the house to the lobby after the auditorium has cleared. You may invite your family and friends to greet your performer in the lobby. There will be no exceptions to our backstage policies.

COSTUMES/HAIR/MAKE-UP

TIGHTS, SHOES AND MAKEUP KITS FOR ALL PERFORMERS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE SPOTLIGHT SHOP AT FSPA. YOU MUST HAVE: TIGHTS: AS PER YOUR DRESS CODE (OR AS SPECIFIED FOR YOUR COSTUME).

SPECIFIC DRESS CODE SHOES AND TIGHTS ARE REQUIRED FOR SPRING CONCERT (No Exceptions!) New purchases should be made by Friday, May 8th in The Spotlight Shop.

- 1. All costume pieces and shoes should have the performer's name on them. Please press or steam any piece that needs it. Come to the show in your first costume and bring other costumes to performances in a zippered clothing bag so pieces don't get lost. Net can be pressed on a low steam setting. Chiffon requires a low dry setting.
- 2. Tights and ballet slippers must be CLEAN. Press pointe shoe ribbons before each performance. Wash tights after each show. Do NOT put them in the dryer.
- 3. NO VISIBLE UNDERGARMENTS!!! NO bra straps or underwear should be visible. The Spotlight Shop sells under-overs and transition bras that will work with most any costume style!
- 4. Each performer should have with them a bag with a small can of hair spray, bobby pins, safety pins, needle and thread, hair brush, lipstick, blusher, and eye brow pencil.
- 5. HAIR IS TO BE DONE AT HOME. Make sure that all loose ends are pulled back and sprayed. No fancy "hair-dos"! Consult choreographer or director for appropriate hair style.
- 6. Make-up is to be applied at home for DRESS REHEARSAL and ALL PERFORMANCES. Make up kits are available in The Spotlight Shop. Use a make-up base that is slightly darker than the normal skin tone; dark brown eye brow pencil for brows and black pencil for eye-liner. Use brown eye shadow. Other colors are unacceptable and will be changed. Wear a true red lipstick (not orange or pink and no frosts) and a coral blusher. Company dancers should apply full ballet make-up. Boys: tawny blush and a dark lip color are sufficient.

BACKSTAGE VOLUNTEERS

<u>Please sign up with Kim Rezendes at krezendes@fspaonline.com</u> if you are available to help <u>supervise the children backstage during any of the performances.</u> We have a large cast in each show and need volunteer help for supervision. If you are supervising a show, you are <u>not</u> allowed to watch any part of that show from the house, but you will be allowed to watch your child from the wings. Please be sure you are volunteering for a show you do not need to see from the front. THANK YOU!!!
